What it is:

Sponsors for *One Meal Matters* work in groups of 6-8 Volunteers to serve a meal on Saturday for approximately 40 clients in our nutrition program at the Daire Center. Sponsors provide the Volunteers, meals, supplies, set up / clean up, and games or activities for the event.

How it works:

Requirements:

Each Volunteer must complete and sign the included Volunteer Application to participate in the event. The completed applications must be submitted by 2:30, prior to set up, the day of the event.

The Details

Start Planning

- Designate a specific liaison from your group who can help coordinate and communicate with AIN.
- Have your group liaison contact Isaac Lobo (Isaac@AINDallas.org or 214-943-4444) to schedule your event and begin pre-planning.

Gather Your Volunteers

- Provide 6 8 Volunteers to set up/break down, serve food, and interact with the Clients.
- AIN Staff member(s) will be present to assist throughout the event.

Customize Your Event

Option 1 - DIY Event

- With this option your group plans and provides prepared mains and sides, desserts, and drinks for 40 people. This option is perfect for groups who want to get hands-on with planning and preparing a unique experience.
 - Provide food from restaurants or other purchased food that was originally prepared in a commercial-grade kitchen*.
 - Examples of drinks include sweet tea, unsweetened tea, Kool-Aid, soft drinks, etc.*
 - 100 paper plates (for food and desserts)
 - 50 disposable cups (12-16 oz., please provide ice, if needed for your drinks)
 - 100 paper napkins
 - Cutlery (and serving utensils) 100 plastic forks, 50 plastic knives, 50 plastic spoons

Event Activities

- Our Clients LOVE Bingo. AIN has all of the supplies. If you choose this option, please provide 5 6 Bingo Prizes. Suggestions for prizes include:
 - Travel-size toiletries, cosmetics, and sunscreen
 - Re-usable water bottles
 - Non-perishable snack foods, protein bars, and candies
 - First Aid supplies
- Don't like Bingo? Other DIY activity ideas include skits, sing-a-long, board games, arts and crafts, or other group activities.

Event Schedule:

- 2:30 Volunteers arrive for set up
- 3:00 to 3:45 Meal is served
- 3:45 to 5:00 Games and clean up
- 5:00 Event concludes

*Dallas County health regulations do not allow us to serve foods that have not been prepared in a commercial-grade kitchen. We cannot accept or serve "home-cooked" items.

Option 2 - AIN Coordinated Event

- This option features pre-planned catered meals from popular restaurants. You provide the Volunteers and AIN makes all of the arrangements for meals, supplies, and Bingo prizes. These meals are the most popular with our Clients and Volunteers. Each option requires a minimum donation and serves up to 40 people.
 - Summer Picnic (Minimum Donation \$500) KFC 3-piece Box Lunch with Mashed Potatoes, Biscuit, and a Chocolate Chip Cookie. Soft drinks (water, iced tea, and lemonade or Kool-Aid) are included.
 - Mexican Fiesta (Minimum Donation \$850) Ojeda's Taco Bar features hard and soft Tacos, Rice, Beans, Taco Trimmings and Condiments, Chips, Queso, and Salsa. Soft drinks (water, iced tea, lemonade or Kool-Aid) are included.
 - Roman Holiday (Minimum Donation \$1375) Olive Garden Spaghetti with Marinara Sauce, Chicken Parmigiana, Fettucine Alfredo, Salad, Breadsticks, and Dessert. Soft drinks (water, iced tea, lemonade or Kool-Aid) are included.

Event Activities

• AIN has all the supplies for bingo, an easy, fun game the Clients love. Prizes for Bingo are provided by AIN and are included in the minimum donation amount.
