Joni Wysocki serves as Assistant Executive Director of Access and Information Network (AIN), where she has been part of the organization since 2016. She was recently promoted from Director of HIV Services and now oversees the day-to-day operations of AIN's core programs, including Medical Transportation, Case Management, Medical Case Management, Linguistic Services, and the Daire Wellness Center, which encompasses Respite Care and the Nutrition and Meals Program.

Ms. Wysocki holds a Master of Science in Criminal Justice Administration from Tiffin University in Ohio, a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice, and an Associate of Science in Correctional Technology from the University of Toledo. She brings more than 25 years of experience in social support and human services to her role.

At AIN, Joni played a key role in reestablishing Case Management services upon joining the organization in 2016. This initiative was critical to strengthening linkage to care and improving retention in care for individuals living with HIV across the Dallas metropolitan area.

Prior to her work at AIN, Joni spent many years with Lucas County, Ohio, where she supervised thousands of individuals convicted of felony offenses. During this time, she focused on empowering clients to create meaningful, long-term change in their lives. She developed a Job Readiness Program to help participants gain skills for sustainable employment and facilitated a weekly relationship-focused program designed to strengthen or rebuild relationships between clients, their children, and co-parents. Additionally, Joni was instrumental in developing a Fatherhood Initiatives Program that increased average child support payments by more than 64 percent among participating clients.

Joni has also volunteered with a variety of social service organizations in both Ohio and Texas, supporting efforts related to social justice and community education. She has served as a guest speaker for institutions and organizations including the University of Toledo, The Senior Source, Lourdes College, and Lucas County Job and Family Services.
